

## Feeding and Potty Schedule

5:30 Am- Wake up, Lights on, Potty Immediately

6:00 AM- Feed Time

6:15 Am- Potty

Before you go to work once last potty time

Kennel

3-4 hours let out for potty and food break and potty again

When you get home, potty, then play and potty again

7 PM- Dinner time, potty 15 minutes after

Play hard, your puppy has been waiting to play with you all day! Do constructive play such as working on sitting, leash training, and other simple commands AFTER going crazy for a ball or toy, while also working on commands.

9PM- last potty break, lights out!

If your working from home I strongly encourage to find multiples times a day to be able to crate your puppy without them seeing or hearing from you.

INDEPENDENCE must be learned. It will make it easier for going out of town or longer away days. Its great that you have all day to devote to your puppy but just need to make sure they are learning how to entertain solely on their own.

For potty use one specific door that will not be used for play. Use the backyard or patio door that is more so used or hangout area for the play door. A bell can be hung on potty door. This will differentiate potty time and play time but remember it must be made into a daily routine. We do not suggest potty pads.

After an accident use a stern voice, show them their mess, and put outside the potty door, while supervising.
